

## College & Career Readiness Internship Program Overview: Summer 2021

What are the expectations of intern employers?

- Provide a safe and supportive environment where SFUSD interns can practice job skills, learn about a career field, and contribute to the success of the work site.
- Assign an on-site staff member to oversee and support student interns throughout the duration of their internship.
- Serve as a role model for college readiness and career exploration.

How can my work site benefit from hosting SFUSD interns?

- Gain extra support for tasks, projects and/or events.
- Build relationships with potential future colleagues.
- Pride in supporting local youth development.

What types of tasks or projects can SFUSD interns do?

- Office support: clerical tasks, events, marketing, and fundraising support.
- Job shadowing: observe operations and/or employees.
- Direct services: work with clients, help with hands-on tasks, or other physical work.

REQUIRED HOURS	<ul> <li>75-150 hours for the summer.</li> <li>Approximately 20-25 hours a week.</li> <li>Hours are flexible.</li> </ul>
DATES	<ul> <li>June - July 2021</li> <li>Option to extend to the end of July and/or continue to host intern(s) into fall or spring.</li> <li>Schedule interns around your vacation days where needed.</li> </ul>
TIMES	<ul> <li>Interns can work in the mornings, afternoons, or all day depending on their CCSF class schedule or availability.</li> </ul>
HIRING & PAYMENT	<ul> <li>Interns are recruited, hired and paid by SFUSD.</li> <li>Interns receive a stipend or an hourly wage (\$16.50/hour)</li> </ul>
SUPERVISION & SUPPORT	<ul> <li>Employers must designate an on-site staff member to oversee interns.</li> <li>Early College will provide an SFUSD staff member to guide interns and support employers.</li> </ul>
