Small/Diverse Supplier Labels on Shopping Homepage


 Previously, there was no indication which hosted catalog and Punch-out suppliers were small businesses or were diverse suppliers (i.e. minority owned business, women owned business, etc.) from the Shopping Homepage





Small/Diverse Supplier Labels on Shopping Homepage


- Now there will be captions on the hosted catalog and Punch-out suppliers stickers on the Shopping Homepage indicating if a supplier is a small business and/or diverse supplier

Improved Requisition Warning Messages Language


- Most hosted catalog and Punch-out suppliers are sent purchase orders electronically from BearBuy to the supplier's ordering systems
- Suppliers often do not accept some information such as notes or attachments on these types of orders
- There are warning messages in the cart and in the requisition indicating notes and attachments are not allowed
- These notes do not impact whether the order can be processed





Improved Requisition Warning Messages Language

- The language for the warning message now provides additional guidance and clarity
 - Indicates why information such as notes and attachments should not be included on the order
 - Clarifies that the warning messages are for notification purposes only and does not prevent the order from being placed
